LEGEND: **SUBRANGE**

The title may list a range of events which can limit the evaluation to just figures, or dance, etc.

Judges

This column has the name of each judge.

Events Judged / People Judged

This is the total number of events this judge judged during the meet and the total number of people in all these events.

Final Events / Finalists

This is the number of events this judge judged which were finals and the number of people in these events.

Overall Placements

These statistics are measured across all events judged by this judge and includes Elimination, Final, and Semifinal events. Only contestants getting placements or qualifying to the next round are evaluated.

Ave Err (Average Placement Error)

This is the average number of strikes involving contestants who placed or qualified for the next round. (Total strikes / number of placing skaters)
A strike is the absolute value of the difference between the placement the skater received and the ordinal given by the judge.

If a judge gives a skater first place and they get first place, it is zero strikes. If the skater gets first place and the judge gave them third, it is two strikes.

Right On

This is the percentage of the time that the judge's ordinal matches the placement

Rating Thirds

This is where the judges average error ranks with the other judges, top third, middle third, bottom third

Relevance

This field indicates how relevant the Rating Thirds is based on the number of events judged. More events -> more relevant
List of judges ordered by number events judged, then the third with the most events is high, second third is medium.

Final Placements

These fields cover the same statistics as 'Overall Placements' but only for final events. Note: CIPA events are grouped with Final Events

Qualified

These fields deal with elimination and semifinal events. This gives the number of skaters qualifying to the next round
in events this judge judged and the percentage of the time that this judge qualified the skaters who actually qualified

Placed

These fields deal with final events. This gives the number of skaters placing in final events judged by this judge and the percentage of the time
the judge gave a placement to a skater who actually got the placement. It does not differentiate between different placements, just whether
they got the right set placing. That is, if the judge gave them 2nd place and they actually ended up with 3rd, that does not count against them.
Only if they placed and the judge said they should not place or the other way around.

Extra skaters qualifying from Regional Championships to National Championships are included in the tallies.
